1. If a child were struggling to breathe, what would you do? First, explain how you know he/she is struggling to breathe.
2. What would be an age-appropriate activity that you might do with a 3-year-old?
3. If a child were to respond to a request you made of him/her as, "I don't have to do what you say! Your not my mommy", how would you respond to that situation?
4. What would be a typical lunch you may prepare for a 6-year-old?
5. Please write about what forms of discipline that you use (in general), or would use on the following age groups: 2-4, 5-8, 9-11.
6. Would you be comfortable working in a childcare situation of 4 or more children? If yes, what is the maximum amount of children you feel confident working with at one time?
7. Many infants require special care, such to help develop their emotional and independent abilities in life. What type of "special care" would you consider that an infant would require (i.e. cuddle time)?

8. If you were working with a family who had a teenager, would you consider the following to be appropriate:
  - a. Leaving the teen alone for any length of time (even if you are staying with the family overnight, or in length); If you feel partial towards this question (i.e. in various given circumstances, you would...instead of all or nothing)
  - b. Allowing the teen to have a party at the home if you are there and the parents are not
  - c. Allowing them to watch rated R movies if not 18 yet
  - d. Encouraging/not encouraging him/her to complete their "chores/responsibilities"
